### **AIMS & OBJECTIVES :**

1. To provide a sound education of both mind and body and the development of character in every pupil.
2. All round development of our students intellectual, physical, emotional and spiritual abilities.
3. Fostering critical thinking, creative ability and intellectual excellence.
4. Formation of good Indian Citizens, deeply loyal to God and the country.
5. Development of concern towards the poor and the weak.
6. Solidarity as an Institution without caste or communal prejudices.
7. Cultivate values like truth, forgiveness, self-sacrifice, love, honesty, justice and concern for others.
8. Show respect to every religion and have tolerance in day-to-day interactions with the neighbours

### **ADMISSION :**

Our school is open to all classes of students irrespective of caste and creed. Every candidate for admission must be presented to the Principal/H.M. in person by the parent / guardian who will stand responsible for the conduct, duty and study of the student.

Admission forms for Nursery /L.K.G. are available at the school office from 1st April onwards. These forms should be duly filled in and signed by the parents/guardians must be submitted to the Principal/Headmaster by the end of April.

A student coming from other school should produce the Transfer Certificate issued by the head of the School and duly counter signed by the concerned education officer, should accompany the admission form. In case of fresh admission to the 1st Standard, birth certificate has to be attached.

**SCHOOL UNIFORM :**

Every student must wear the full uniform prescribed by the school and it must be neat and clean. The meaning of the uniform is meant to inculcate in the students a sense of decorum, equality with others and feeling of oneness. In case a student fails to wear the uniform for a specified reason, the parents should write in the diary where the prescribed format is provided for this purpose.

**RELIGIOUS AND MORAL EDUCATION :**

To maintain a good moral conduct, we offer a course in religious and moral education in all classes. This moral training aims at developing the balanced personality of every pupil and develop a sense of discipline, appreciation of the highest ideals of character and respect for God's creation.

**PAYMENT OF THE SCHOOL FEES :**

The prescribed fee for each section could be paid in total at the beginning of the year or in three installments, half at the beginning and the remaining in September before the mid-term examination and in December. At any rate, no school fee would remain due on the 1st of February. No student will be allowed to answer the semester examination unless and until all the fees are paid without any arrears.

**TEST AND EXAMINATION :**

Four tests and two semester examinations will be held in an academic year. After each test and examination, the marks cards will be sent to the parents/guardians for the signature. They should be duly signed and returned within three days. No pupil may remain absent for **any test or examination except when prevented by reason of health** in which case a medical certificate has to be produced. **No re-test or re-examination** will be arranged for any pupil on account of **his/**



**her absence from a test or examination.** The student who has failed for the first time may be allowed to repeat the year. But the student who has failed for the two consecutive years, T.C. will be issued.

**INSTRUCTIONS TO THE PARENTS/ GUARDIANS :**

1. Parents co-operation is very essential for the proper education of the children.
2. Parents must watch and guide their children's studies at home. Children need constant attention and encouragement to improve the performance.
3. It is the duty of the parents to provide necessary infrastructure and material for their daily duties at home.
4. Children should not be kept at home or **called for during working hours for unnecessary and trifle reasons.**
5. Parents are requested not to ask for permission to collect their children in between the school hours. Please send the child for the entire day. Half day permission will not be granted. In case of emergency parents are requested to collect their children personally. They will not be sent with people who claim to be their relatives, unless the children themselves ascertain it.
6. Parents should meet the class teacher through Headmaster and discuss about the progress of the child at least once a month. On all working days from 4.30 p.m. to 5.15 p.m. is the suitable time for the parents to meet the teachers.
7. Parents are absolutely forbidden to enter the classroom or walk on the verandah when the classes are on. They are advised to contact in the school office or in the Headmaster's office for any necessity. They may meet the teachers before or after the class hours only.

8. Parents are requested to sign the progress reports or any other similar documents when requested. Failure to do so may put them to great inconvenience.
9. Parents/guardian are requested to make known their grievances or complaints **directly to the Head Master** and not to the teacher concerned.

### **NORMS FOR PUPILS CONDUCT :**

All pupils must abide by the school rules of conduct and discipline and must bear in mind the following points :

1. Speaking in English is a must when at school.
2. Punctuality, regularity and cleanliness are expected from every student at all time.
3. Running, playing or shouting inside the school building is not allowed.
4. Irregular attendance, misconduct, insubordination to teacher etc are sufficient reasons for permanent or temporary dismissal of a student. Other offences are punishable according to the gravity of the offence.
5. When a student has been absent from school or has come late, valid reason for the action has to be entered in the calendar signed by the parent/guardian should be counter signed by the Head Master before the student enters the class.
6. No books (other than text-books and school library books) may be brought to the school without the permission of the Head master.

7. The school is not responsible for the articles lost. It is not advisable to bring valuable articles like expensive watches, ornaments of gold or silver garments etc, to the school. No mobile telephone is allowed. Books, Tiffin carriers, sweaters should bear the name of the pupil and he/she will be the sole responsible person for its safekeeping.
8. No student is allowed to leave the school premises during the working hours without the explicit permission of the Head Master.
9. Students should take pride in lending a helping hand at all school functions and take active part in all the co-curricular activities organized by the school even if it is meant to stay back after the school hours.
10. Students are strictly prohibited from taking part in any public demonstration or to join any political groups.
11. If leave is required due to illness or any other reasons the student should send a leave note or should bring it along when he/she comes to the class next. The parents/guardians should sign every leave note. Prior permission should be obtained personally by the parents/guardian for a leave beyond 5 days. In case of absence due to ill health, medical certificate should be produced.
12. All the students should learn to make good use of the furniture, books etc, If any damages are made to the school property, they are expected to pay for the repairs. Students are forbidden to disfigure or write or scribble on walls or furniture and to throw paper in and around the classroom.
13. Students should be diligent in their duties and come to the class well prepared with daily lessons and with their homework carefully done.

14. No student suffering from contagious or infectious disease will be permitted to attend the school.
15. Students absenting from semester exam's are not eligible for promotion.
16. Late comers shall report to the P.E. Teacher or the Headmaster and obtain permission to enter the class.
17. Games and physical exercises are compulsory as an essential part of physical education. Any claim for exemption from the same be supported by valid medical certificate. During the games period no student is allowed to sit in the classroom.
18. The school places great emphasis on regularity obedience, politeness, courtesy, cleanliness and neatness. Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, neglect of homework, misbehaviour even outside the school premises, and insubordination to school authorities justify disciplinary action against the student. Every student should show respect to the Headmaster/Principal, Teachers and Elders by words and gestures. They should not be ashamed even to touch their feet and ask for blessings.
19. Every student must have a copy of the calendar and it should be brought to the school everyday. Parents should carefully go through the calendar daily and sign their remarks.
20. Any student absconding from his home or school for any reason, more than 2 days will be dismissed from the school.

**SMART CLASS :**

The introduction of smart class has brought some newness to our curriculum. Hence it is also a part of our school curriculum. It is introduced to all the classes from Nursery onwards. So a prescribed fee will be collected from every student towards smart class.

**SCHOOL BUS SERVICE :**

School bus service is provided to the students who have to reach from far off distance. The specified monthly bus fee has to be paid before the 10th of every month. We collect the bus fee for 11 months and for every 4 months bus fee has to be paid in advance. However parents are free and responsible to arrange any kind of transport to bring the children to the school.

**EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES :**

Periodically the school organizes debates, quiz, singing competition, essay competition etc., that the students may develop the power of public speaking and acquire the quality of leadership. Games and physical education is given special importance during the school hours. Special coaching for Kho Kho, Volleyball, Music, Dance, Cricket will be given. Students are also prepared to participate in the various inter school competitions.
