- All explanatory notes for absence and late arrive should be handed over to the class teacher. No one who is late or has been absent on the previous day will be admitted to the class without the permission of the headmaster
- 4. Outside the vacation period, pupils are not granted leave. Hence, prior permission should be sought for absence from the school for any reason known or planned in advance
- Students will not be allowed to leave the school before the stipulated time unless parents/guardians present a written request to the headmaster
- 6. Any student requiring leave for any part of the day on account of sudden illness or such unavoidable circumstances should obtain the permission of the class teacher and the headmaster before leaving the school. Leave record signed by parent/guardian should be submitted to the headmaster on the next working day

Code of Conduct

All the pupils must abide by the school rules of conduct and discipline and must bear in mind the following points:-

- Pupils should be punctual and regular
- Pupils should be in correct, neat, clean and tidy uniform
- Books or Magazines not approved by the school authorities must not be brought into the school; in case they are brought, they shall be confiscated
- Speaking in English is a "must" when in school. The respective language must be used during the language classes
- The primary civic duty is to guard public property. School property
 is public property and care should be taken to protect it. Any
 damage done to school property must be made good by the parent
 or guardian of the child
- Every student must have a minimum of 75% attendance to be eligible to appear for the annual exams/be promoted to the next class
- Students should not carry mobile phones to school, if found with mobiles, the same will be confiscated and returned only at the end of the academic year 16

General Discipline

- It is vital that changes in residence/office addresses and telephone number be communicated in writing to the office immediately when they occur
- Pupils are advised not to have private tuitions. Parents are urged to encourage their children to do their daily work diligently and honestly and to pay utmost attention to the studies in the class room. If there be real need for help and special attention, kindly contact the headmaster
- Parents are encouraged to have their children undergo medical examination regularly for general well-being, specially dental, eye and ear care
- Collection of funds for whatever use is forbidden without prior permission of the headmaster
- 5. The school is not responsible for the articles lost. It is not advisable to bring valuable articles like expensive watches, ornaments of gold or silver garments, etc. to the school. Books, Tiffin carriers, sweaters should bear the name of the pupil and he/she will be the sole responsible person for its safe-keeping
- Every student must have a copy of the school calendar and it should be brought to the school everyday. Parents should carefully go through the calendar daily and sign their remarks when required
- Each student's safety is a major concern of the school,
 Therefore the following should be strictly observed
 - a) parents of pre-primary students are required to teach their children their names, address and telephone numbers by-heart
 - b) if the child has to go to a place other than the normal one, a note from the parent must be sent to the school, requesting permission and stating the reason for a child to go to a different place after the school

Parent – Teacher Interaction

- The co-operation and good will of the parents is an essential component of an effective parent-teacher relationship in order to provide maximum educational opportunities for children. The school needs the involvement of parents in many of its activities
- Parents and guardians shall co-operate with the school by adhering to the rules and regulations as amended from time to time
- Parents should see that their children are dressed properly a n d neatly with the particular uniform prescribed for the day
- Parents are encouraged to give positive suggestions for the improvement of academic standards
- Parents are requested to supervise the daily Homework of their ward and duly sign their homework diary every day after the completion and counter check and thus co-operate with the teachers
- It is the duty of the parents to provide necessary infrastructure and material for their daily duties at home
- Children should not be kept at home or called for during working hours for unnecessary and trifle reasons
- 8. Progress cards of the students after each semestral examination are to be collected by the parents personally from the class teacher and to be duly signed in the presence of the teacher. This will help the parent-teacher to have a dialogue about the ward and take adequate steps to improve the over all growth of the ward
- Parents are absolutely forbidden to enter the classrooms when the classes are on. They may meet the teachers before or after the class hours only
- 10. No parent is allowed to walk on the verandah or enter the classroom for any reason. They are advised to contact in the principal's chamber for any necessity

- Parents/guardian are requested to make known their grievances or complaints in writing directly to the principal and not to the teacher concerned
- All dues must be cleared before a student is admitted to the terminal and final examinations

Evaluation & Promotion

Regular unit tests, monthly tests and terminal examinations are held each year and promotion is based on total performance at these tests and exams and regular attendance. It is the policy of the School not to fail a student as far as possible. At the same time a student who has not acquired the necessary skills to study in a higher class may not be promoted. Anugraha School is interested in providing additional possible facilities for slow or weak learners to acquire the needed skills if parents cooperate with the School in this regard. However, the school strongly discourages the practice of excessive home work, special tuition, etc.
